### Child care for Washington families

Answering more than **23,000** phone and internet inquiries, CCR helped more than **18,000** families find the best quality care for their children.

### Higher quality early learning programs

Our staff trained and coached **1,552** licensed child care providers in King and Pierce counties who collectively care for **32,900** children. As part of Early Achievers, Washington's Quality Rating and Improvement System, we continually help increase the quality of care for ALL children.

### Increased diversity in the child care workforce

More than **62** refugee and immigrant women graduated from our Child Care Careers Program well-prepared to care for children in early learning programs. More than half of all graduates were employed shortly after graduation.



CCR's programs, which support parents, child care providers, and caregivers, strengthen our community and build a better future by ensuring all of our children can access quality child care that prepares them for life.

### Stable environments for homeless children

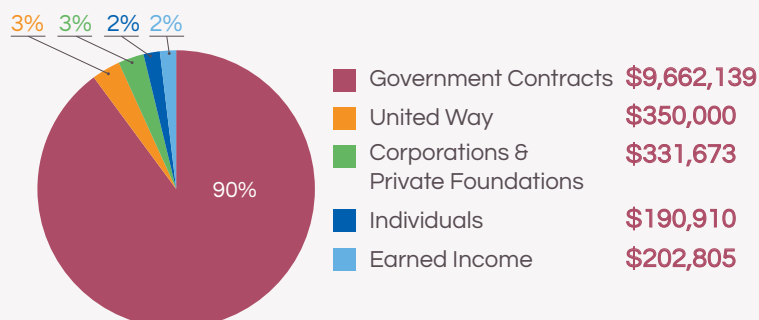
CCR ensured more than **250** homeless children could access emergency short-term child care and helped another **200** homeless children access other critical resources. These programs provided children with stability and quality child care in the midst of a family crisis.

### Skills and community for informal caregivers

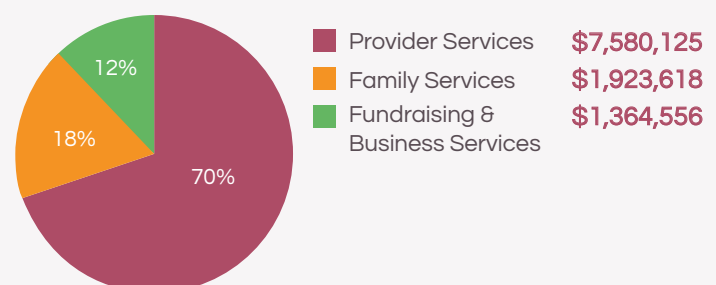
More than **6,700** children and **5,400** caregivers participated in our Kaleidoscope Play & Learn program. This program provides support for the family, friends, and neighbors who care for an estimated **75%** of all children under five in our state. Information and resources provided help increase caregivers' understanding of child development and school readiness.
